Tzur is called here the האש אמות of Midian. He was the most important of the rulers of Midian. Yet, in next week's Parsha, he is only listed third among the rulers. Because he spoiled his reputation by encouraging his own daughter to get Yidden to do Aveiros, the Torah devalues his position as well. The great Telzer Roy, R' Yehuda Leib Bloch, zt"l asked, why would Tzur care about what it says in the Torah about him? What sort of "Potch" is this for him to not get appropriate recognition in some Pasuk? He wasn't alive anymore when it was written and who is going to notice it anyway?

If this is a question to you, then you don't think in terms of the נצחיות of the Torah. Eternity is a long time. Did someone ever push ahead of you in line at the store? Did someone ever grab the parking spot you were waiting for? Wasn't that annoying, frustrating, even enraging? For how long did the sense of injustice last? An hour, a day, longer? This is a Pasuk in the Torah. It is an eternity of being pushed out of line, of being passed over for someone not as prominent as you. In this world and in the next world, the eternal words of the Torah continue to knock and demote this once-mighty ruler. Forever and on, Tzur is feeling the "Potch" and kicking himself for being such a short-sighted fool. Yidden, who live their lives with an eye toward the next world, don't stay only focused on the happenings and experiences of this world. They learn to focus on what will make a difference – for eternity – in the world to come.

R' Dovid Feinstein, zt"l, explains that Pinchas could have easily found good reasons why Zimri should not be killed. The fallout would be too great. He is a Nasi, a Prince. His fellow Shimonites wouldn't let Pinchos get away with it. He might be killed himself. Usually, the name Pinchas is written without a Yud. 57 /5 – He might have Rachmanus. The Yud here intervenes. Hashem created the world with Yud and Hey. Hey is this world, where there is plenty space to fall out on bottom, but you can climb back up and find the opening to do Teshuva and get back in. The Yud is the next world. It is a small because it is reserved for the few Tzadikim amongst the many undeserving in this world. The Yud helped Pinchos stay focused on the everlasting Chesed he was doing for Zimri, by stopping him short from continuing down a path of destruction and eternal ruination.

R' Moshe Feinstein zt"l, used to point out how you can see how Yiddishket and Yiras Shomayim seems to matter less to many people nowadays. There used to be fights and arguments when someone was passed over for an Aliyah in Shul. A "Kibbud" in Shul was a mark of recognition and acknowledgement of one's place and standing in the community. Even the simple, unlearned members of a community felt a sense of משיבות for the Kibbudim in Shul. You don't see that too much nowadays. It doesn't seem to bother us so much anymore. Prominence and status now comes from more worldly involvements. Gone is the sense of importance for our eternal place in the line of forever.

We make so many choices, big and small, in our daily lives and lifetime decisions, as well. Sometimes we choose to become annoyed and even lose our temper. Insert the 'kleinchikeh" Yud and keep the world of eternal recognition in your sights. The satisfaction of a good and worthy choice will last forever.






