

At the beginning of the Parsha, Moshe Rabbeinu mentions Nahar Pras as a boundary of Eretz Yisrael and refers to it as "Hanahar Hagadol, the Big River." Rashi explains that since it was mentioned with Eretz Yisrael it was called "hagadol", even though it was not really part of Eretz Yisrael. Rav Chaim Shmulevitz points out that we see from here that Eretz Yisrael makes everything that is associated with it bigger and better. The Nahar Pras was the smallest river, yet since it was associated with Eretz Yisrael it was referred to as hagadol. He explains that this is true by many other things as well. Chazal tell us that ain Torah k'Toras Eretz Yisrael, which means that limud haTorah in Eretz Yisrael is better than limud haTorah outside of Eretz Yisrael. The Ramban also points out in a number of places that the hashgacha that Hashem has for Eretz Yisrael is more direct than anywhere else. This is why nevuah only exists in Eretz Yisrael, as well as numerous other halachos. Rav Chaim asks why the people who are living there don't always feel this higher level of Kedusha and closeness to Hashem. He explains that Chazal tell us that Moshe asked Hashem why Yosef's bones could go into Eretz Yisrael, but his couldn't. Hashem responded that when Yosef met Pharaoh he referred to himself as an Ish Ivri, someone who was from Eretz Yisrael.

However, when Yisro's daughters told their father that they had been saved by an Ish Mitzri, an Egyptian man, Moshe didn't protest that he was really an Ish Ivri. Since Moshe wasn't modeh bah, he didn't admit and proclaim to be from Yisrael, he was undeserving of entrance into Eretz Yisrael. Rav Chaim asks, however, that when Yisro's daughters referred to Moshe as an Ish Mitzri they were also implying that he wasn't Jewish, yet we don't find that Moshe was punished for not refuting that claim, so why was he punished for not refuting their claim that he was a mitzri? Rav Chaim answers that entrance into Eretz Yisrael only for those who are modeh bah is something that Hashem set up in the world as a fact. One can only feel the kedusha of Eretz Yisrael, and merit the special hashgacha of Eretz Yisrael, if he is aware of it and is modeh to it. Since Moshe didn't do that it would've been impossible for him to enter it. On Tisha B'Av we mourn the destruction of the Beis Hamikdah, destruction of Yerushalayim, and the exile from Eretz Yisrael. The only way we can merit having those things restored is if we daven for them and are modeh to them. We have to feel like we need them and that they should be part of our lives only then will we merit to see Moshiach b'meheirah b'yameinu, amen




First half in the books?? Cray-cray!
