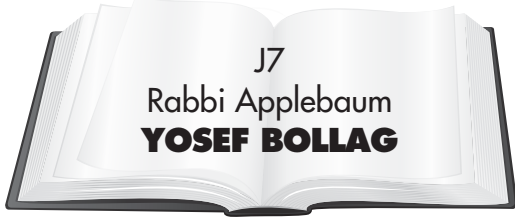

What an important lesson!

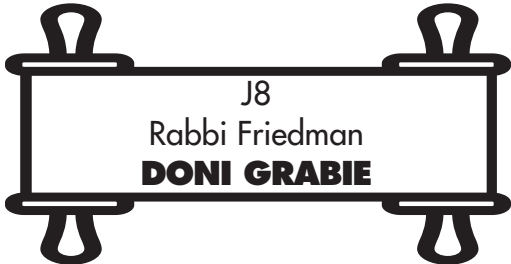
