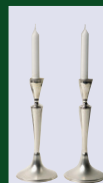

# Torah B'Simcha

ראה

In Parshas Re'eh, we find the mitzvah of *lo sisgodedu*. On the simple level this means that one may not injure himself out of mourning and sadness after somebody passes away. However, the *Chachamim* learn an additional commandment from these words. The word *sisgodedu* has the same root as the word *agudah*, which means a group. The pasuk is teaching us not to form separate factions; that we should not allow *machlokes* to create different groups with different sets of *halachos* (although different *minhagim* are valid). Rav Moshe Feinstein asks, what is the connection between not injuring oneself in mourning to not forming different factions? Why, indeed, are these two mitzvos learned out from the same word?

He answers that the reason we do not injure ourselves is because we must view

ourselves as children of Hashem, as the beginning of the pasuk states *banim atem l'Hashem*. It is not proper for the physical appearance of children of a king to be damaged. Similarly, says Rav Moshe, as children of Hashem it is not proper for our spirituality for us to be divided in different factions. Such division “damages the *ruchniyos*” of Bnei Yisroel.

As we go through our daily lives, and especially in camp, we often encounter people from different background, from different schools, with different customs, with a different nusach of davening... they may even be blue whereas we are red!

Our challenge is to remember that, in reality, we are all just different parts of the singular unit of Bnei Yisroel and to treat each individual as they deserve, as a child of Hashem.

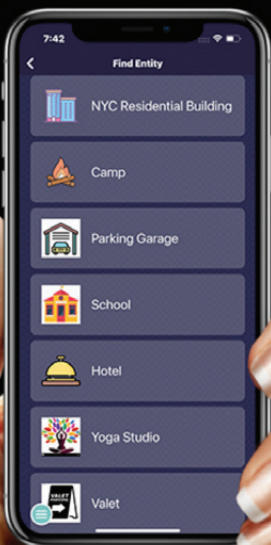

- 5 Find your child's bunk to find a list of all his staff members. Staff members will be listed under each bunk. You can also search by the staff member's name.
- 6 Enter tip amount and a note if you wish.
- 7 Click continue then pay - select your payment method. You can pay by credit card or with your checking account. Follow the prompts to pay.
- 8 Once you hit send, the staff members are immediately notified (by email and push notification). Parents will also get a receipt via email.
- 9 If you have any trouble using the app, please contact grazzee directly through their website or app.
