The last carpool has left.


The last piece of lost & found has been found.

The last knish has been knished.



The last splash in the pool has been splashed.


Don't forget Payday. Lots of money was flying all over the






which head staff member is getting (got) married on August 13th? Answer- ME!!!!!!





.....(Gasp for air) Wow!!! I did it!!! Wipdedo!!! I said all of our summer in one breath!! That was fun!!



Congratulations to the shofar blowers for setting a **MIDZ** record for the most runs scored in single game with **37** runs


Congratulations to the OlehRegelars for setting the **20S** record the most runs in a single game with **31**.

Thank you to everyone who made **YACHAD @ SIMCHA** an unforgettable experience, with many more memories to come.


